Spring has arrived...Let the fun begin

Now that Spring has arrived, our dormant grass is beginning to come back to life and with the growth season in full effect, weeds are anxious to take control

As we embark on the active growing season, we thought it may be good to offer a few thoughts/reminders that will keep our neighborhood looking good and remaining a sought after place to live:

- Spring is the best time to prevent weeds by incorporating a pre-emergent weed control which will prevent weed seeds from germinating
- Incorporating a weed and feed maintenance program into the lawn will help maintain a healthy, strong and weed free yard that you will be proud of all season long

- Aeration, Dethatching, Mowing, Watering and Insect Control are all important elements to maintaining a strong and healthy yard
- Where erosion may have occurred, filling the area with soil and planting grass seed now will help eliminate the unsightly roots
- Taking time to trim the shrubs will help promote spring/summer growth and provide a well maintained curb appeal

So dust off the mowers, pull out the trimmers and lets turn our yards into the oasis' that other neighborhoods expect to see when visiting Arbor Ridge!





What needs to be knocked off the list?

Now that being outside is more tolerable, please take a moment to evaluate your property and address any repairs that may have surfaced during the winter.

Uneven sidewalks, worn or damaged fences and mailboxes that still need painted with updated numbers just to name a few. Addressing general maintenance early will save time and money if tackled early.
