

# Notice regarding proper mulching

The Bob Ray Company, which has been treating our ash trees over the past few years, has indicated that a number of trees are at-risk due to improper mulching. In particular, Bob Ray's arborists noticed that several trees have excessive mulch piled up around the tree base, which can lead to insect and disease problems.
